Due Date

This Notification for Compliance Status is due within 60 days of the applicable compliance dates specified below:

1. A GDF constructed before November 9, 2006, is considered an existing source and must comply with NESHAP 6C by January 10, 2008.
2. A GDF constructed or reconstructed before January 10, 2008, and after November 9, 2006, is considered a new source and must comply with NESHAP 6C by January 10, 2008.
3. A GDF constructed and started up after January 10, 2008, is considered a new source and must comply with NESHAP 6C at the time you commenced operation.

¹ *Gasoline Dispensing Facility (GDF)* means any stationary facility which dispenses gasoline into the fuel tank of a motor vehicle, motor vehicle engine, nonroad vehicle, or nonroad engines, including a nonroad vehicle or nonroad engine used solely for competition. These facilities include, but are not limited to, facilities that dispense gasoline into on- and off-road, street, or highway motor vehicles, lawn equipment, boats, test engines, landscaping equipment, generators, pumps, and other gasoline-fueled engines and equipment.

² *Monthly throughput* means the total volume of gasoline that is loaded into, or dispensed from, all gasoline storage tanks at each GDF during a month. Monthly throughput is calculated by summing the volume of gasoline loaded into, or dispensed from, all gasoline storage tanks at each GDF during the current day, plus the total volume of gasoline loaded into, or dispensed from, all gasoline storage tanks at each GDF during the previous 364 days, and then dividing that sum by 12.
