

# NESHAP 7D IN / NOCS

## INITIAL NOTIFICATION / NOTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE STATUS FOR PREPARED FEEDS MANUFACTURING SOURCES<sup>1</sup>

### Due Date

For affected sources, this Initial Notification is due no later than 120 days after initial startup or May 5, 2010, whichever is later.

For existing affected sources, this Notification of Compliance Status is due on or before May 4, 2012. Sources constructed or reconstructed on or before July 27, 2009 are considered existing sources.

For new affected sources, this Notification of Compliance Status is due no later than 120 days after initial startup or October 18, 2010, whichever is later. Sources constructed or reconstructed after July 27, 2009 are considered new sources.

<sup>1</sup> *Prepared feeds manufacturing* means a facility that is primarily engaged in manufacturing animal feed that uses a material containing chromium or a material containing manganese and is an area source of hazardous air pollutants. A facility is primarily engaged in manufacturing animal feed if the production of animal feed comprises greater than 50 percent of the total production of the facility on an annual basis. Facilities primarily engaged in raising or feeding animals or in the growing of agricultural crops used in the manufacturing of feed are not prepared feed manufacturing facilities.
