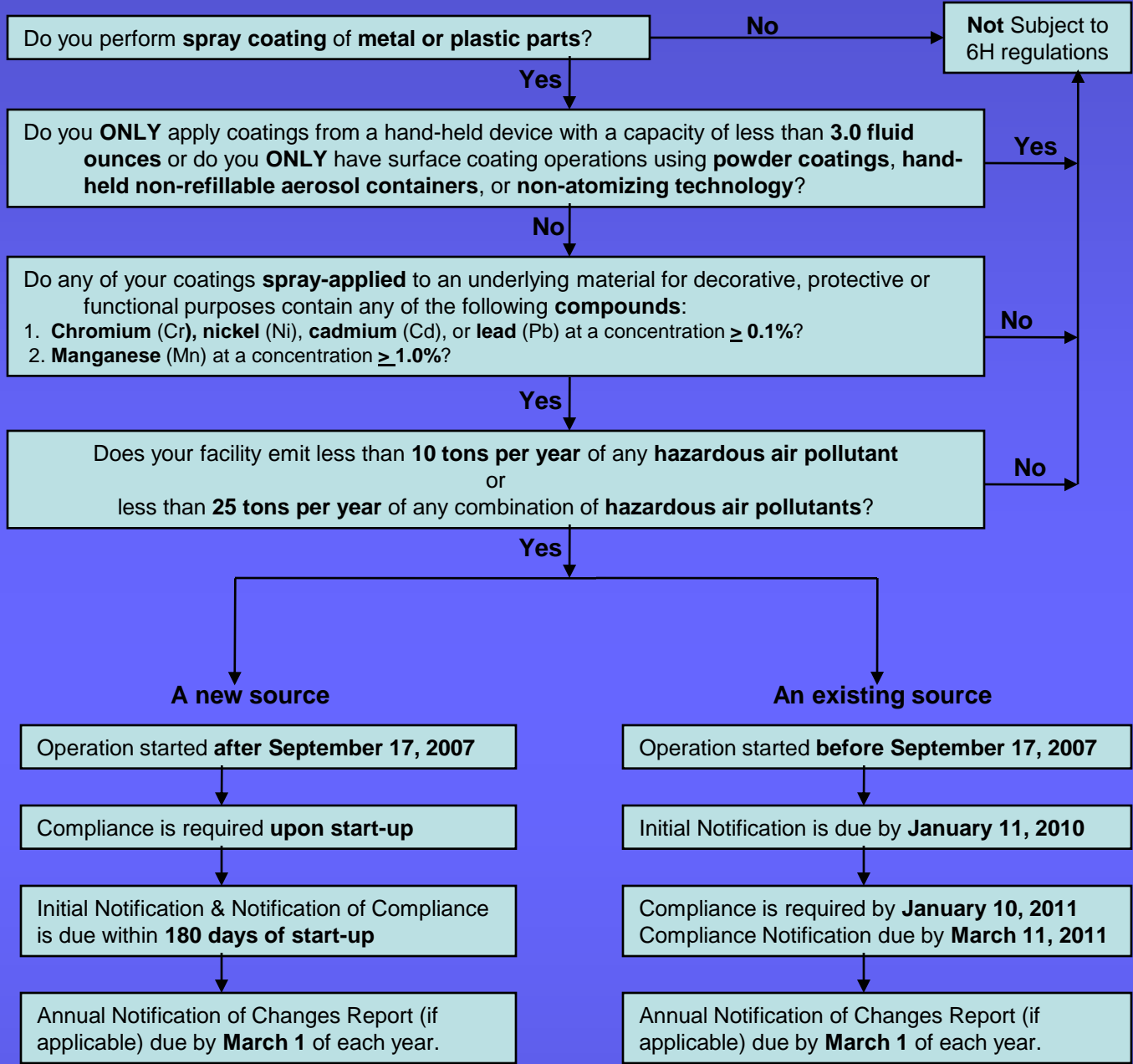


# How Do Surface Coating Regulations (6H)\* Apply to My Operation?



\*6H refers to the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP): Paint Stripping and Miscellaneous Surface Coating Operations at Area Sources [40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 63, Subpart HHHHHH]. 6H does not apply to surface coating operations that are covered under a different area source NESHAP, such as the area source NESHAP for metal fabrication and finishing [40 CFR, Part 63, Subpart XXXXXX].
